In the recent past you have read Splash NewsBulletins and Forum Q & A's that concern the severity of the "run off" problem...rains washing out pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers from residential, farm land, golf courses etc. Below is an interesting "tip of the week" we picked up on from one of our many trade journals demonstrating how each of us at our homes can help reduce the amount of run off and improve our own immediate environments.

Our Water and Wastewater Tip of the Week is courtesy of Sandra L. (Shane) Turpen, a chemist/lab tech at the City of Branson -- Public Works Wastewater Treatment Facility in Branson, Mo. She writes, "I get a lot of inquiries this time of year about the safe use of different herbicides and their toxicity to the environment. I am concerned about the effect of possible runoff into our lakes in the area. I try to always pass on this bit of information. A lot of the herbicides on the market contain acetic acid (vinegar) in some concentration. For home use, I use a dilute acetic acid solution in a spray bottle (set on stream) and spray in the center of the weed to be evicted, trying not to spray the surrounding area."
