*New Jersey is mandating **all private wells to be tested** before closing on the sale of property. **This is very significant for two reasons. The contaminates to be tested have increased and it is the sign of things to come for all states.***

In order for a homeowner on well water to sell their home, they will need to have performed and passed water quality testing for the following:

Mercury, radium, lead, arsenic, benzene, MTBE Coliform, nitrates,, iron, manganese, pH, lead and so-called volatile organic compounds such as benzene and trichloroethylene, a dry cleaning agent, arsenic.

Failure to pass will require the owner to purchase and install POE and / or POU in order to complete the sale.

In Brief: NJ mandates testing of all private wells

TRENTON, NJ — A New Jersey law unveiled Tuesday requires water-quality testing on all private wells before any real estate sale, a move state Department of Environmental Protection Commissioner Bradley Campbell said brings to over 390,000 private well users the same protection public users have had since 1996 — mandatory testing, the *Express-Times* reported.
